SHEAT Public School embraces a structured approach to prepare our scholars for a globalised, digital, and ever-changing world.

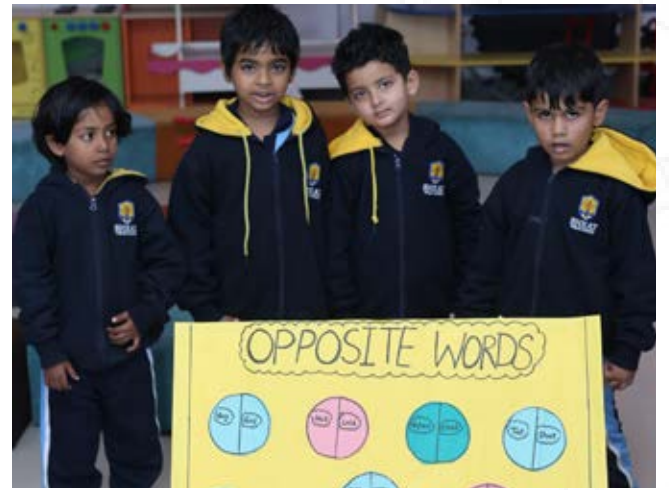

- At SHEAT, we follow a multidisciplinary approach based on students' psychology. Our program ignites creativity and critical thinking by stimulating all the four lobes

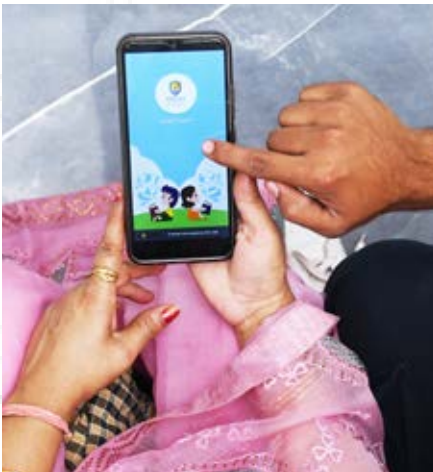
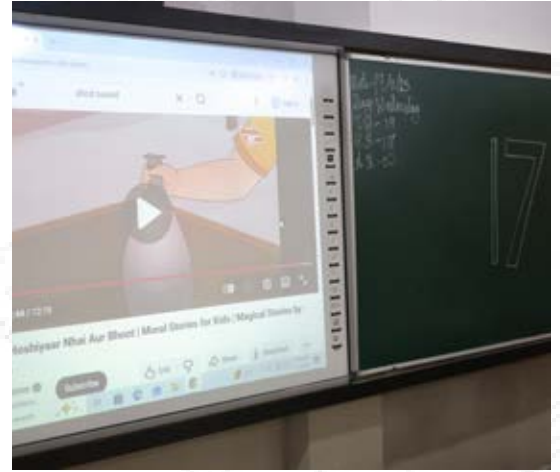


of the brain, enhancing cognitive capacity and fostering a holistic learning experience tailored for young learners.

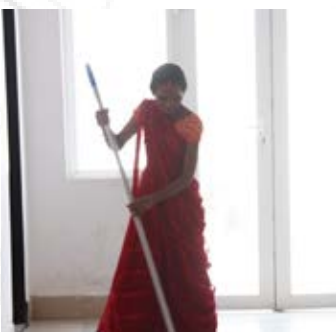

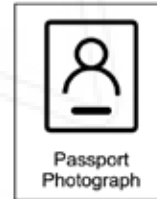
